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1.0 POLICY STATEMENT

It is the Rehab Groups policy to have arrangements in place to ensure that if a programme of education and training ceases prematurely, learners will be able to complete a similar programme with another provider, or have their moneys refunded where fees apply.

2.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to outline the arrangements that will be made to ensure that Learners are protected in the event of a programme ceasing.

3.0 SCOPE

This policy applies to all programmes of training and education of three months duration or more and moneys have been paid by, or on behalf of, the learner.

4.0 DEFINITIONS

Protection of Enrolled Learner – a requirement to put in place arrangements to ensure that if a programme ceases prematurely, learners will be able to complete a similar programme with another provider.

5.0 GENERAL PROVISIONS / PROCEDURE

Essential Steps

1. Notify QQI in writing the arrangements in place to protect enrolled learners when submitting each programme for validation.
2. Demonstrate that the alternative programme is similar to the programme ceasing.
3. Provide details of the enquiries made/steps taken to ensure that the PEL arrangements are adequate and meet the legal obligations under the 2012 act.
4. Complete the QQI PEL arrangement documents if a programme ceases.

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- A. Alternative Programme Arrangements
- B. Fee Refund Arrangements
- 5. Document how a new provider will access learner records.
- 6. Inform learners about the arrangements in place if a programme ceases.

6.0 ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Members of the Quality and Governance Directorate responsible for quality assurance and development of programmes are responsible for the implementation of this Policy Document.

7.0 EVALUATION & AUDIT

This policy on protection of enrolled learners will be evaluated and reviewed through the Rehab Groups review and audit processes. This policy will be reviewed in line with the Rehab Groups policy on policies framework.
